## **"HAXHI ZEKA" UNIVERSITY EXPANDS ACADEMIC HORIZONS: DOCTORATE IN BUSINESS AND ECONOMICS NOW ACCREDITED!**

“Haxhi Zeka” University has received accreditation from the Kosovo Accreditation Agency for the doctoral program “BUSINESS AND ECONOMICS” at the Faculty of Business. This is an important step in strengthening the research and academic capacities of the university. With this accreditation, UHZ becomes the second university in Kosovo to offer doctoral studies, after the University of Pristina.

This program will contribute to the development of scientific research and provide opportunities for the advancement of knowledge in the field of business management. It will also increase the quality of higher education in Kosovo and provide opportunities for students who wish to develop their academic careers.

This achievement highlights UHZ's strategic commitment to becoming an important center of academic and research development in the region, contributing to the advancement of higher education and the local economy.



## **SUCCESSFUL ACCREDITATION OF STUDY PROGRAMS AT UHZ – 2025/2026**

"Haxhi Zeka" University in Peja has successfully completed the accreditation phase of study programs for the academic year 2025/2026. This process, carried out by the State Quality Council (SQC), has confirmed the university's commitment to providing quality education and meeting contemporary academic standards.

Thanks to the joint work of the academic and administrative staff, most of the programs were successfully accredited, guaranteeing the continuity and further development of the study offer at all levels. This is a significant step towards strengthening the position of UHZ as a public higher education institution with a focus on quality, innovation and professional development.

"Haxhi Zeka" University will offer a total of 20 accredited study programs, of which 8 at the Bachelor's level and 11 at the Master's level and 1 Doctorate.

From June 30 to July 14, 2025, the fourth edition of the International Summer University – UNISUM 2025, a renowned academic platform for international exchange and innovation in higher education, was successfully held at the “Haxhi Zeka” University in Peja. The program was held in two phases: the first week in an online format, while the second week with a physical presence on the premises of the UHZ, offering flexibility and broad international involvement.

UNISUM 2025 brought together more than 100 students and professors from over 10 countries, including Finland, France, Poland, Turkey, Hungary, Albania, the USA, Ireland, the Netherlands, North Macedonia and Kosovo. The program offered 11 multidisciplinary courses, designed to address global challenges in areas such as green economy, strategic communication, globalization, digital finance, digital criminal justice, leadership, etc.

In addition to the quality academic content, participants also engaged in practical workshops, international cultural activities and professional networking, making UNISUM a rich experience in both academic and human terms. “Haxhi Zeka” University confirmed through this edition its commitment to internationalization, intercultural cooperation and sustainable development in higher education.



# "HAXHI ZEKA" UNIVERSITY HOSTS THE LARGEST SCIENTIFIC CONFERENCE OF THE YEAR WITH PARTICIPANTS FROM OVER 21 COUNTRIES

From July 10 to 13, 2025, the "Haxhi Zeka" University in Peja has become a center of international knowledge by organizing one of the most important academic events of the year – the international conference "International Conferences, July 2025", with the participation of researchers from more than 21 countries in Europe, Asia and America with over 100 papers. The conference has gathered high-profile professors and researchers, who presented dozens of scientific papers from various fields such as economics, law, technology, education and social sciences. This activity emphasizes the university's commitment to advancing its research mission and strengthening ties with international academic networks.

In his opening remarks, the Rector of UHZ, Prof. Dr. Armand Krasniqi, emphasized the importance of this event for promoting international cooperation and the role of the university as a contributor to knowledge, innovation and social development. The conference was realized thanks to extensive cooperation with local institutions and international partners, positioning UHZ as a credible and active actor in the global academic arena.



# "HAXHI ZEKA" UNIVERSITY IS HIGHLY RATED IN THE ORCA REPORT ON ACADEMIC INTEGRITY - LEADER IN THE QUALITY OF SCIENTIFIC PUBLICATIONS

"Haxhi Zeka" University in Peja has emerged as one of the most highly regarded institutions in the country for academic integrity and quality of scientific publications, according to the final report published by ORCA (Organization for the Enhancement of Quality in Education) for the year 2025. This report, based on data from the international platforms Scopus and Web of Science, strongly reflects the scientific advancement of UHZ and its commitment to academic norms.

The report highlights that UHZ has the highest percentage of professors who justify their academic titles through scientific work, as well as a significant increase in publications. The university is also notable for the significant number of papers with international impact, reflecting the increase in research capacities and the efficient management of academic policies.

This success is part of the HEI'25 project, funded by the Austrian Development Agency (ADA), with the support of MASHTI and the Kosovo Accreditation Agency, and implemented by KEC in cooperation with ORCA. "Haxhi Zeka" University thus confirms its leading role in the field of scientific research and academic integrity in higher education in Kosovo.

## THE INSTITUTE FOR SCIENCE AND ARTS AT UHZ ANALYZES THE CRITICAL CHALLENGES OF THE ACCOMMODATION INDUSTRY IN DUKAGJIN

The Institute for Science and Arts within the "Haxhi Zeka" University has published an exclusive research report, which examines the current state of the accommodation industry in the Dukagjin Region, highlighting the deepest challenges and priority needs for the development of the tourism and hotel sector.

The report highlights several key issues such as: lack of professional training, the need for human capacity building, investments in hospitality infrastructure, as well as the mismatch between market demands and current supply. A particularly important aspect highlighted in the report is the untapped potential of cooperation between universities and the private sector, especially in the field of tourism and hospitality.

This study was carried out within the framework of the Research-Based Teaching Grant, supported by the Ministry of Education, Science, Technology and Innovation (MASHTI) and funded by the Austrian Development Agency (ADA) through the HEI'25 project, implemented by KEC and ORCA. The publication of this report confirms the role of "Haxhi Zeka" University as an active research center in addressing regional challenges and developing strategic sectors in Kosovo.

# "HAXHI ZEKA" UNIVERSITY CONTRIBUTES TO THE CONFERENCE OF THE MINISTRY OF REGIONAL DEVELOPMENT

On May 7, 2025, the Ministry of Regional Development organized in Pristina the conference entitled "The Role of Universities in Balanced Regional Socio-Economic Development", which aims to strengthen cooperation between academic and state institutions to address socio-economic inequalities between regions.

From the University "Haxhi Zeka", the Vice-Rector for Teaching, Student Affairs and Scientific Research, Prof.Assoc.Dr. Alma Shehu participated in this organization. She, together with Prof. Xhavit Rexhaj, presented the topic "The Role of Universities in the Promotion and Advancement of Cultural and Historical Heritage in Function of Regional Development in Kosovo".

During the presentation, the importance of universities' engagement in the "third mission" – community impact and regional economic development – was emphasized. One of the concrete examples was the Tourism Barometer, a research tool developed by UHZ and the Terra World organization, which analyzes the economic and social impact of tourism in the Dukagjin Region.

This commitment demonstrates the active role of "Haxhi Zeka" University in creating development policies and strengthening the connection between higher education and the local community.

- Reserve tables at favorite restaurants
- Transportation and additional services are organized, all in an automatic and coordinated manner!

## "HAXHI ZEKA" UNIVERSITY BRINGS CIVIL SOCIETY CLOSER: INSPIRING MEETING WITH DUKAGJINI NGOS

The Rector of "Haxhi Zeka" University, Prof. Dr. Armand Krasniqi, together with his team, organized an inspiring meeting with representatives of non-governmental organizations from the Dukagjin region.

This informal meeting turned into an important moment of dialogue and rapprochement, where one of the University's most promising projects was presented - the construction of the Business Incubator in the heart of UHZ.

With this initiative, "Haxhi Zeka" University, with the support of the Ministry of Industry, Entrepreneurship and Trade and the Municipality of Peja, is laying the foundation stone of a new center for innovation, entrepreneurship and sustainable economic development. The incubator, emphasized Rector Krasniqi, will be a space where the ideas of students and young people will come to life – with mentoring, institutional support and cooperation networks with the private sector, NGOs and municipalities.

- This collaboration is an important step towards sustainable involvement of society in the work of the university, promoting institutional cooperation and local capacity building.





## SEMINAR “VALUES, SPORTS AND SPECIAL NEEDS” – MAY 2025

On May 3, 2025, a seminar dedicated to “Values, Sports and Special Needs” was held at the Faculty of Law of the “Haxhi Zeka” University in Peja. The special guest was Lieutenant Colonel Gianfranco Paglia, a former soldier wounded in the mission in Somalia (1993), who later regained his life by contributing in Kosovo, Bosnia, Iraq and Lebanon – and today, as an advisor to the Italian Minister of Defense, promotes the inclusion of people with special needs through sports and education. Paglia conveyed the message that physical obstacles are not the end of the road, but an opportunity to seek higher goals. Sports and education are key tools for integration, empowerment and personal development. The university, as the rector emphasized, is the bastion of inclusion and inclusive education, which will inspire students to practice values such as honesty, solidarity and respect.

The seminar was attended by important institutional figures: KFOR command (Major General Enrico Barduani), KSF representatives, local officials, academic and administrative staff, as well as students and interested citizens.



# DELEGATION VISIT FROM IOWA UNIVERSITY TO “HAXHI ZEKA” UNIVERSITY

“Haxhi Zeka” University in Peja welcomed a delegation from the University of Iowa with the aim of deepening academic cooperation and developing joint projects. The meeting was attended by representatives from both universities, including the Rector of UHZ, Prof. Dr. Armand Krasniqi, and experts from the University of Iowa.

The discussions focused mainly on the use of artificial intelligence to analyze the labor market and local business sectors, as a tool to guide the opening of new study branches that respond to real market needs. The importance of cooperation to improve the educational offer and create new opportunities for students was also emphasized.

Rector Krasniqi presented the achievements of "Haxhi Zeka" University in the field of academic advancement, infrastructure development and expansion of international partnerships, as well as the commitment to modernization and quality in education.

In conclusion, the University of Iowa delegation expressed its willingness for continued cooperation in technology, artificial intelligence, and labor market analysis projects, emphasizing the importance of partnerships that create value for institutions and the community.



This project aims to bring higher education closer to the demands of the labor market, increasing the practical skills of students and improving the quality of education in Kosovo. The project coordinator, Prof. Ass. Dr. Suada Ajdarpašić, thanked all partners who contributed to its implementation and emphasized the importance of inter-institutional cooperation for the sustainable development of the region.

# ONE-WEEK STUDY VISIT TO VETMEDUNI UNIVERSITY IN VIENNA-AUSTRIA

The staff and master's level students of the "Haxhi Zeka" University in Peja, led by Prof. Assoc. Dr. Arieta Camaj Ibrahim and Prof. Ass. Dr. Gentiana Gega, carried out a one-week study visit to the University of Veterinary Medicine in Vienna (VetMedUni). Part of this delegation were students Elona Shillaku and Gerta Berisha, who were welcomed by the staff of the institution, under the guidance of Prof. Dr. Elisabeth Varga.

During their stay, participants participated in practical training in food chemical analysis laboratories, using advanced HPLC-MS/MS techniques for research on the topic of their master's degree. This served to deepen their knowledge and apply the methodology to their research projects.

The activity was supported by a research project of "Haxhi Zeka" University, focused on increasing research capacities and developing international mobility, thus strengthening cooperation in the field of food safety.



# UHZ ACADEMIC STAFF IN TRAINING ON INNOVATION AND SUSTAINABILITY IN VAASA, FINLAND

On May 26–30, 2025, four members of the academic staff of "Haxhi Zeka" University participated in a week of training at the University of Vaasa (Finland), within the framework of the GreenWB project.

The training included:

Lectures and workshops on green skills, sustainable development and university-business cooperation [unhz.eu](http://unhz.eu).

Visit to Technobothnia and VEBIC, two renowned centers for innovation and technology.

Presentation of the "green laboratory" established by UHZ, as well as discussion on progress in building a green incubator within the Innovation Center, with support from MINT and the Municipality of Peja.

This activity strengthened the capacities of academic staff, preparing them to support innovation and entrepreneurship at UHZ, in line with the project's goals for sustainable regional development and university-industry cooperation.

The GreenWB project is funded by the European Union's Erasmus+ program and has as its main goal the creation of sustainable and structured connections between universities and businesses, as well as the strengthening of the entrepreneurial skills of students and academic staff in the field of green innovation and sustainability.



# "HAXHI ZEKA" UNIVERSITY AT DIGITAL WEEK 2025 IN NICE

From 16 to 20 June 2025, "Haxhi Zeka" University participated in Digital Week 2025, an international event organized by the Université Côte d'Azur in Nice, France. At this event, UHZ representatives – Prof. Ass. Dr. Alma Shehu Lokaj, Prof. Ass. Dr. Theranda Begiri and Ms. Arberora Haxhijaj – engaged in activities that promote digital transformation and international cooperation in higher education.

Digital Week 2025 brought together over 250 participants from 35 countries and 65 partner universities, providing opportunities for experience exchange and professional capacity development. The event included three blended intensive programs (BIPs) that addressed: digital transformation in higher education, digital skills for teachers, and strengthening internationalization through digitalization.

The participation of "Haxhi Zeka" University in this event emphasizes its commitment to modernizing education and strengthening international ties, contributing to the sustainable development of higher education.
